Know all men by these presents that I Jesse Kilgore late of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand one hundred dollars to me paid by Josiah Kilgore late of the district aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said Josiah Kilgore all that plantation or tract of land, situate lying & being in Greenville District on both sides of Golden Creek waters of Enore River beginning at a white Oak 3x on John Westmoreland Land on the S.E. bank of Golden Creek & runs N. 42 W 33.50 to a Black Oak 3x in the Wagon Road thence N. 23 W 41.50 to a steeping blue oak 3x on the N. side of Peters Creek thence up the meanders of said bank to a large Black Gum 3x being a condition corner being said Josiah & Jesse then on said conditional line to a Hickory Sapling 3x on the bank of Golden Creek thence S 32 W to a Post Oak 3x. Clement Horners corner thence on his line N. 68 E. 51. 20 to a H 3x thence S 17 W E. 13.50 to a Black Gum 3x down on the long branch thence down said long branch to a large Blk. Gum 3x 3x. about 100 yards from the mouth of said branch thence S 80 E 20.50 to a stake on William Johnsons Spring branch thence up said Branch to a maple 3x thence N. 27 W E. 9 chains to a dog wood 3x thence N. 11 W 16. 40 to a Stone 3x thence N. 16 E. 3.50 to the beginning containing by estimation five hundred & twenty one acres be the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Josiah Kilgore his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators, to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Josiah Kilgore his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
