Crays line N. 24. 10. 40. 00. to a holly 3x on the school house branch then up the meanders of said branch to a white oak 3x Honey Brock mans corner thence S. P. Brock mans line to a Post-Oak 3x then N. 49. 7. 10. 56. 25 to a stake then on James Kilgore line S. 36. 10. 47. 00 to a pine 3x then S. 62. E to a maple 3x Mary M. Crays corner then on her line to Peter Creek then down the meanders of said Creek to the beginning Together with all and singular the rights, menses, hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises, before mentioned unto the said Josiah Kilgore his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executor, & Administrator to warrant & for ever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Josiah Kilgore his heirs & assigns against myself and my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 21st of November 1823.
