G. Bradley and Thomas Wynne. Witnesseth that whereas debts to a considerable amount were issued against said Nimrod Underwood as Sheriff of Greenville District at the last of the court of common pleas for S. District and whereas the said above named securities are legally liable for the payment of the said sums of money for which the said rules now issued and are also liable for certain debts assumed by them on account of their liability for the same, as the securities of the said Nimrod Underwood, Sheriff as aforesaid. Now in consideration of the said premises, Nimrod Underwood do hereby assign convey and release to said John Young Thomas Benson Alexander Waddell Thomas Wynne, Wheaton Merritt John Hodges George Russell and Curtis Bradley the property herein after named, and also, hereby authorize and empower them to sell and dispose of the whole, or any part thereof and also to collect all the fees due me as Sheriff as aforesaid and to apply the proceeds to the payment of a debt of one hundred dollars to W. Thompson Esq for his professional services in settling the affairs of the office, and the whole of the balance of the proceeds to be applied so much be necessary to payment of all legal claims against me, as Sheriff aforesaid the said property when sold at such times and on such terms as my said securities above named may in their think fit. The property hereby conveyed is as follows the plantation where I now live my plantation on the waters of Saluda containing about three hundred acres and joining William Bates J. H. Goodlett Mrs E. D.
