E 38. 50. to a red oak 3rd thence South 32. 50. to white oak 3rd on the branch thence up the meanders of the branch to a Gum 3rd thence S 20. E. 26. chains to the beginning which contains the land to be conveyed and contains by a late survey One hundred & fifty six Acres be the same more or less.
