Rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises be-
-longing or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold
all & singular the said land & premises before mentioned unto the said Charles
Wood his heirs & assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
Exors & admors to warrant and for ever defend all & singular said land
& premises unto the said Charles Wood his heirs & assigns against myself
& my heirs or any other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim
