 Hyekeiah Lockrum. Conveyed from Hyekeiah Lockrum to Daniel  
 Lockrum by deed of Gift lying on the South side of Rudy Fork waters  
 of Rudy River Beginning on a stake of the Original line in a march  
 corner of a piece of land deduced to John Gordon running from thence  
 down the Marsh to where it intersects a branch that runs from  
 Isaac Roberts Spring thence down the branch to the Creek thence  
 down the Creek untill a certain white oak will be in line with the  
 next corner a persimmon at the back of said Daniel Lockrum smocke  
 House from thence to the beginning Together with all and singular  
 the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said prem-  
 -ises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, to Have and  
 to Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the  
 said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns for ever, and I do  
 hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant  
 and for ever defend, all and singular the said premises, unto the  
 said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns, against myself  
 and my heirs, or any other person lawfully claiming or to
