in the district and State aforesaid on a branch of Enoree River beginning on a
Stake at the old road thence a long Map Bunsons line to a Spanish oak corner
thence a long Robert Bunsom & his chambers line to a white oak corner thence down
a branch to the fork thereof the other fork to a large poplar thence to the road to a red
oak corner thence along the road to the beginning corner being part of a tract of land
granted to Robert Burns the second day of January one thousand seven hundred
and eighty six. Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appur-
tenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have
and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jacob Glaze
his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises above mentioned unto
the said Jacob Glaze his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs Executors and admin-
istrators and against all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming
