for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me in ha-  
nd paid by George Stetzel of the district have granted bargain-  
ed sold and released by these presents do grant bargain sell and  
release unto the said George Stetzel all that tract or parcel of land  
containing one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less situate  
lying and being in the district and State aforesaid on the waters of South  
Tyger River and waters of Chiddes Bevendam Creek a water of the  
same beginning on a post oak running thence South thirty East thirty  
to a Stake thence North eighty five east thirty five fifty to two Turkey oaks  
thence North thirty five west to a large red oak thence a conditional  
line to the beginning together with all the rights, members, hereditaments,  
and appurtenances to the said premises or in any wise incident thereto  
or appertaining to have and to hold and singular the premises  
before mentioned unto the said George Stetzel his heirs and assigns  
for ever and I do bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrato-  
tors to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said  
premises unto the said George Stetzel and his heirs and against my  
self and my heirs and against every other person or persons whom  
soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
of I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal  
this fifth day of December in the year of our Lord one
