


Release unto the sd Archibald Trauler all that tract or parcel of land, containing one thousand Acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in the State aforesaid, and district of Greenville, on the waters of Rocky Creek Waters of Enoree River, and hath such shape, marks, buttings and boundings as follows viz beginning on a post oak corner thence N. 60. 00. 62. 50 to a post oak, thence N. E. 60. 160. 00 to a white oak thence S. E. 30. 50 to a stake, thence S. W. 60. 160. 00 to the beginning corner which said tract of land was granted to John Goodwin by his Excellency Thomas Pinckney Esq. Governor and Commander in Chief of sd State on the 3rd day of September Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven, together with all and singular the rights, moneys and appurtenances to the sd premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises here mentioned unto the sd Archibald Trauler his heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Exrs and assigns to warrant and for ever defend, all and singular the sd premises unto the sd Archibald Trauler his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs Exrs and assigns against every other person whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof — Witness my hand and seal the 27th day of January Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and seven ten
