Sutherland thence south eighty five degrees East to Chesnut thence north five degrees East twenty seven chain to a red oak thence north eighty degrees West on said line to the beginning on the branch it being part of a tract of land granted to William Anderson January the twenty first one thousand seven hundred and eighty five together with all and singular the Rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Burwell Black his heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the foresaid premises unto the said Burwell Black his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof as
