 district aforesaid hath bargain sold and do by these presents
 bargain sell and release a piece of land unto Young Potts
 lying on the middle fork of Saluda on the south side of
 Gap Creek beginning at the mouth of a little stream on a
 popular corner thence south E. to a blaised Chestnut thence
 a straight line to the original line thence North E. a length
 said line to a branch joining of James Southwestern line
 thence down said branch to the mouth at a pop-
 ular corner thence down said creek to the beginning
 corner containing 60 acres more or less it being for the
 inconsideration of the sum of one hundred dollars in
 hand paid by the sd Young Potts on to Jonathan Potts
 Senr. whose fee I do in warrant the right and title on the said
 Young Potts from myself and the rest of my heirs and assigns
 forever from all other persons having any claim there of
 how use do here unto set our hands and seals this 18th January
 1827. Signed in the presence of us.
