


N. 11. 30. to a post oak thence N. 45. N. 37. 00 to a white oak thence N. 15. E. 10. to a small white oak bush on Wm P. Pools Spring branch and thence N. 45. N. 37. 50 to the beginning Together with all and singular the Rights members and appurtenances to the said land belonging or in any wise appertaining thereunto to have and to hold the said tract of land and premises unto the said William Neaves to him and to his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors or administrators to warrant and for ever defend the above described land and premises from myself my heirs and from every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the all or any part thereof.
