L. Westmorland stands indebted to the said John Moon by his
notes, bearing even date with these presents in the sum of seven
- hundred dollars. Now this Indenture witnesseth that
the said Sterling L. Westmorland, for & in consideration of
the said debt, payable as appears by said notes & for the
better securing the payment thereof, & the said Sterling L. Westm-
- orland do grant, bargain, sell & release unto the said John
Moon & to his heirs & assigns forever all that plantation or
tract of Land on which he now lives, containing 256 acres
more or less bounded on the East by Enoree River, on the
North by Christopher McCarry's land; on the West by Josiah
Hilgore's land & on the South by land belonging to the
Estate of John Westmorland dec'd Together with all and
singular the rights, members & appurtenances therein to belon-
- ing or in any wise incident or appertaining to have
and to hold the said tract of land with the appurten-
- ances unto the said John Moon his heirs and assigns for ever
Provided always never the less & it is the true intent & mean-
- ing of the parties to these presents that if the said Sterling L. Westmor-
- land his heirs Ex^{ors} or assigns shall well & truly pay the said notes
with Costs & Interest then these presents shall be utterly null
