

The State of South Carolina. I know all men by these presents, that J. William Barton of the District of Greenville and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of five dollars paid by Willey Belieu of the District of the State aforesaid do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Willey Belieu a certain piece parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid on the waters of the sink hole fork of Tyger River Beginning on a Branch on a branch John Ericksons corner, thence Westwardly with the several Windings on John Ericksons line till it intersects with William Bartons line on the East side of a my Branch thence to a pine tree to a white oak thence to a Spanish Oak all marked To thence due west to a red oak thence to a Spanish oak thence to a Chestnut thence to a white oak oak all marked To thence to a Chestnut corner on the same direction intersecting with the line of the post oak corner thence North on said line to the Stake corner thence East to the rocky branch by Thos Bowes thence down the meander of the branch to the beginning John Ericksons corner containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident to have and to hold the above mentioned premises, unto the said Willey Belieu his heirs and assigns from me and my heirs and from no other person or persons whomsoever and I do hereby bind my self, my heirs Executors and administrators to quit claim the above described premises unto the said Willey Belieu his heirs and assigns and no further and it is Expressly understood, and the intent and meaning, is that I am only to warrant and for ever defend the above conveyed land from me and my heirs and assigns and no further In witness I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty eight day of August one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight. Signed Seal and delivered in presence of us.
