 Greenville District } that I John Lucas of Spartanburgh
 District & State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one
 hundred dollars to me in hand paid by John Dill of the
 State and district aforesaid for a certain plantation or tract of
 land being in Greenville District on the wild cat branch
 waters of South Tyger River beginning on a ash corner on the
 south side of said branch thence east to a poplar thence a
 straight to a stake corner on the said Pagers line near the
 Wagon Road on the North side of said Road thence Strait on
 said line to a stake corner on Joseph Earens line thence an
 Evans line to the branch that runs through his plantation
 on thence down the branch to the Fork thence up the rocky
 Cat Tail branch to the beginning corner the same one hun-
 dred acres more or less together with all and singular the
 rights, minter, hereditaments, & appurtenances to the said
 premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have &
 hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 said John Dill his heirs & assigns & administrators & I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant
 and for ever defend all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said John Dill his heirs & assigns against
 myself & my heirs Executors & administrators & against all & every
 other person or persons whatsoever claiming the same or any part
 thereof In witness whereunto I have set my hand & affixed
 my seal this 16th September Eighteen hundred & twenty four
 in the forty ninth year of American Independence, signed
 & sealed & delivered in the presence of:
