 dollars paid by Francis Bowen as aforesaid and in order to full-
 fill the agreement between my said brother & myself have gran-
 ted bargained sold & released and by these presents doth Grant Bargain
 in sell & release unto the said Mary Bowen the widow & to James James
 Bowen Charles M. Bowen & Sarah J. Bowen the children of the said
 Francis Bowen deceased a certain tract of land situate in Greenville
 District on Ruddy River, containing one hundred and twelve more
