 by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release, unto the said Doctor
 Robinson M. Earle all that tract or parcel of land situated in
 Greenville District and State of South Carolina on Peady River
 Containing four hundred and ten acres 410, be the same more
 or less bounded by a line from the Red Oak corner on the old road
 at a place called the sandy Hollow thence S. 61. W to Gen Adams line
 thence S. 24. W to said corner white Oak corner which is down thence to
 a gum corner on the bank of the River at the foot of the bridge the
 old bridge is ment thence down the River to the mouth of the
 Creek called the flat bank branch thence up the said creek
 or Stokes line to a hickory in the old road called Hilllets Road thence
 up the said Road with its meanders to the beginning. Together with all
 and singular the rights, members, hindrances, and appurtenances to
 the said premises bearing or in any wise incident or appertaining
 To Have and To Hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned
 unto the said Doctor Robinson M. Earle his heirs and assigns for ever and
 we do hereby bind our selves, heirs, Executors, and Administrators, to warrant and forever
 defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said Doctor Robinson M. Earle
