Goodlett of the said State & district for and in consideration of the Sum of fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Zion Goodlett of said State and district Have bargained, sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain, sell & release unto the said Zion Goodlett a certain tract or piece of land containing ten Acres be the same more or less situate & lying in the State & district aforesaid on Rich Land Creek Commencing at a post on said Creek at Earles old longyard running thence South 56 west five Chains 75 links to a stake thence S 45 East Eight Chains 30 links to a poplar corner thence North 24 East 1 chain 90 links to red oak thence S 81 East to Chestnut 2 chains 65 links thence N 86 E 4 ch 62 li to Chestnut thence due East 3 ch to poplar thence N 82 E 3 ch 50 li to Chestnut corner thence S 82 E 2 ch 84 li to red oak thence S 45 E 7 ch to poplar thence S 44 1/2 E 8 ch to poplar thence N 55 E 2 chains 90 links to white oak on bank of said Creek thence up the meanders of said Creek to the post at the beginning Together with all the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said Zion Goodlett his heirs and assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Zion Goodlett his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs & every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 20<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 1829.
