said sum of fifteen hundred shall not be chargeable to the said
Micaiah Pickett Jr. individually but to be deducted from
the whole sum of money coming to the legal heirs of the said Micaiah
Pickett and Kisanah Pickett which said sum of money
be the said James Pickett in to hold & keep to his own proper use
and benefit for ever as witness my hand and seal this 8th day of September
