 wise incident or appertaining, And I do hereby Covenant to war-  
 -rant and forever defend all and singular the premises here-  
 -mentioned and released unto the said Heirs of the said Samuel Cra-  
 -yton and their heirs forever; And that I have not heretofore sold  
 mortgaged or otherwise disposed of the said piece or parcel of  
 land to any person or persons whatsoever, And I hereby convey all  
 the right and title which I ever had or may or can have hereafter to  
 my distributive share of the tract of land of which my Father died  
 seized and possessed, by virtue of his will or other wise to the said heirs  
 of the said Samuel Crayton and their Heirs forever. In witness whereof
