E. 5. 78. to a small white oak 3x thence to a hickory N. 16. E. 67. 20. to a Stake 3x in William Nelsons field N. 74. W. 66. 70 to a Stake 3x in a waggon Road thence N. 16. W. 9. 33. thence N. 65. W. 12. 1/2 to a hickory 3x thence S. 25. W. 32. 30 to a forked Maple 3x on the River thence down the meanders of the River to the beginning Sweet Gum corner a lineable to a resurvey of the said land made by James Whitten Esqr on the 22 day of March 1816 hereunto annexed and the land now intended to be conveyed was originally granted to Thomas Davis & by him conveyed to Sulcer & wife John Gower and by him willed to me and now from me to George Dill as a reference to the said John Gowers will and to the several conveyances, will more fully appear containing four hundred and thirty two acres in the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To Have and To Hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George Dill his heirs and assigns for ever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said George Dill his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs or any person or persons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
