 that J. Josiah Parrott of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid
 for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty
 dollars to me in hand paid by Benjamin Nilson of the State
 and district aforesaid have granted bargained and released
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release to the said
 Benjamin Nilson one hundred and sixty acres of land be the
 same more or less the said land lying on the south side of
 Pyles branch water of Pedy River Originally granted
 to James A. Pollard and signed by his Excellency Joseph
 Alston on the 17th Nov. 1814. and laid out as follows begi-
 -ning on a pine not corner on Thompson Dickersons line
 thence to a black Jack thence to a white oak on the south side
 of Pyles branch thence up the meanders of said branch to a condi-
 -tional corner on said branch thence to a R. O. thence S. 90° W. 15. 20
 to a skumut 3x. thence S. 30. E. 39. 20 to sd. J. Dickersons 3x. thence N. E. a
 long sd. Dickersons line to the beginning including one hundred and
 sixty acres of land more or less together with all and singular the
 rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
 as belonging in or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and
 to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 said Benjamin Nilson his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs and Executors to warrant and for ever
 defend the same unto the said Benjamin Nilson his heirs and
 assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and every other per-
 son or persons what soever lawfully claiming or to claiming
 the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have set my
 hand and seal this the 8th of February 1826. in presence of
 Samuel Carter Samuel Rice J. Josiah Parrott

South Carolina. Personally came Samuel Rice before me one of the Justices of the
 Greenville District Peace for said District and being duly sworn sayeth on Oath that
 he saw Josiah Parrott sign seal and deliver the within deed of conveyance to
 Benjamin Nilson for the use & purpose within mentioned and that he also saw
 Samuel Carter sign the same as a concerning witness with himself sworn
 to and subscribed before me this 9th October 1829
