 Greenville District } these presents shall come I Alexander McKin-  
 -ney of the State and District aforesaid do send greeting know ye  
 that I the said Alexander McKinney for and in consideration of  
 the natural love and affection which I have and bear unto  
 my Daughter Anney Hood and also for the good cause and  
 considerations me thereto moving have given, granted, and  
 confirmed unto the said Anney Hood her heirs and assigns for  
 ever a tract of Land containing three hundred and fifty acres  
 more or less, excepting a few Board trees, lying on the waters of the  
 North Fork of Saluda known by the name of the Hood tract  
 of Land joining George Salmon & Samuel McCarrell also one negro  
 girl by the name of Sophia together with her <sup>Issue and</sup> increase to  
 have and to hold all and singular the said tract of land and  
 the said Negro girl Sophia unto the said Anney Hood and  
 her heirs for ever to her own proper use and behoof to  
 belong to, owned, by and bejoined only by the said Anney Hood  
 and her heirs for ever and I the said Alexander McKinney  
 do warrant by these presents and for ever defend the said  
 tract of land and the Negro girl Sophia as a bona discretus  
 unto the said Anney and heirs for ever. In witness whereof  
 I have herunto set my hand & seal this 21 day of November  
 1829 J<sup>r</sup> George Russell, Caswell Barrett.
