 received the said several sums of money all our right, title interest  
 and Estate of inheritance to which we are entitled to, in the real  
 Estate of our late father Map. Statten deceased, containing one  
 hundred acres be the same more or less, and being three shares ~~two~~  
 of equal to one half, there being six legals, situated lying, and  
 being in the District of Greenville aforesaid on the North side of  
 the Middle fork of Saluda river bounded by the Mayfield  
 Tract together with all and singular the rights, numbers, heredita-  
 ments and appurtenances to the same belonging TO HAVE  
 and TO HOLD all and singular the rights, numbers, heredita-  
 ments and appurtenances to our said undivided shares be-  
 longing, incident or appertaining to the said Isaac Ford  
 and his heirs forever as fully as we might or could, and  
 we do hereby bind our selves our heirs Executors and admin-  
 -istrators to warrant and forever defend all singular the  
 said premises to the said Isaac Ford and his heirs against  
 ourselves our heirs and against every other person or  
 persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof  
 Witness our hands and seals this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March A.D. 1837
