

Know all men by these presents that I Joseph Wood of Granger County Tennessee for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by William Butler of the District of Greenville and State of South Carolina Have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Butler all that tract or parcel of Land situate in the District of Greenville on the waters of the Middle fork of Tyger River Beginning at a Chestnut running thence So. 26. E. 46 chs to a Hickory thence E. 7 chs. 50 lks to a red Oak, thence N. 24 E. 20. chs to a red Oak, thence N. 55. E. 23. chs to a Chestnut thence N. 55. W. 27 chs 50 lks to a white Oak thence N. 28. W. 9 chs 50 lks to a white Oak thence N. 50 W. 7 chs 50 lks to a Chestnut thence So. 50 W. 28 chs to the beginning containing one hundred and eighteen acres more or less Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to Have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Butler his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Butler his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs, Executors Administrators, or assigns and against all and singular the Claims of every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the twenty eight day of December one thousand eight hundred and eighteen signed, sealed and delivered in presence of
