 public Vendue, and purchased by Joseph McCullough of the  
 District of Greenville for the sum of sixty dollars being the highest  
 sum that was bid for therefor Now Know Ye that I James Mc  
 Daniel Esqr Sheriff aforesaid, by virtue of said writ of fieri Fa-  
 -cias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid, and by  
 virtue of the statute in such case made and provided and for and  
 in Consideration of the said sum of sixty dollars to me in hand  
 paid or secured to be paid by the said Joseph McCullough the  
 receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have  
 granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bar-  
 -gain and sell unto the said Joseph McCullough his heirs and  
 assigns forever, the said tract piece and parcel of land, with  
 its appurtenances, and all the Estate, right, title and interest the  
 said James Holland deceased of right had of in and to the  
 same To Have and to Hold the said piece parcel and tract of  
 land with its appurtenances, unto the said Joseph McCullough  
 his heirs and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely, as I the said  
 James McDaniel Sheriff, might could or ought to grant, bargain  
 in and sell the same, by virtue of the statute aforesaid, and  
 the said writ of fieri Facias or otherwise I'm witness  
 whereof, I the said James McDaniel Esqr. have hereunto set my hand  
 and seal the twenty third day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
