 all that parcel of land containing twenty one and one fourth  
 acres beginning on a small red oak on the Lawrence Road running  
 north along the said road to a Hickory thence along the line of the  
 said W. Thompsons line to a rock corner thence on the line which  
 divides the land hereby conveyed from the Land of <sup>Mr</sup> Guinness  
 Cleveland to a large black oak thence to a stake corner thence  
 to two small white oaks and thence to the beginning according  
 to the courses and distances described in a plat hereunto annexed  
 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditame  
 nts and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise  
 incident or appertaining to the said Waddy Thompson Jr.  
 his heirs or assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my  
 heirs Executors administrators and assigns to warrant and  
 forever defend all and singular the premises to the said Waddy  
 Thompson his heirs or assigns for ever against the claim of all
