said South Carolina by virtue of writ of Habeas Corpus issued out of the  
Court of Common Pleas held for the District of Greenville tested the  
twenty seventh day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and twenty seven at the suit of Andrew Johnson, vs Thomas  
Hutchings. to me directed, Commanding me that of the goods and Chatt-  
-les, lands and tenements, of the said Thomas Hutchings to levy the  
sum of thirty four dollars and fifty eight Cents, damages and costs.  
I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements, of the said Thomas  
Hutchings, all that certain piece, parcel and tract of Land,  
Containing three hundred acres more or less situate and being in  
the District of Greenville on both sides of Enore River bounded  
by William Moore, Lister Richard, James Brown, John Mayfield,  
and Thomas Woods And whereas the said premises with their app-  
-urtenances, since the seizure by me made by virtue of the said  
writ of Habeas Corpus before mentioned, have been Exposed
