& runs S. 20 E. 40 Chains P.O. 37 N. 80 W. 31.50 Chain to P.O. 37 thence N. 19 E. 48.28.
Chains to maple 37 on the South side of a branch thence down the
meander of said branch to the beginning which contains the land
to be conveyed Together with all and singular the rights members here-
=ditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging do hereby warrant
and for ever defend the rights and titles of the above described premises
unto the sd. Free strike his heirs Executors & administrators to be held
in trust by the sd. strike, future Guardian for sd. strike and
his heirs for ever against myself my heirs Executors & administra-
=tion and against any other person or persons lawfully claiming
the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 28th
October A.D. 1828 And the fifty second Year of the American
