The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents <sup>331</sup> that I Lemuel Cobb of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred dollars to me paid by George Seaborn of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid Have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said George Seaborn his heirs and assigns all that plantation or tract of Land situate lying and being in the dist aforesaid and in the fork of the Beaverdam <sup>& Mountain</sup> Creek of Saluda River containing Two hundred and thirty five acres more or less which sd tract is laid off to the sd Seaborn as follows viz beginning on a Stake XIII. on a line of the tract purchased by the said Seaborn of Ransom Cobb and running S 56.° E. 26.75 Chains to a Hickory XIII near the spring an James Medwards line thence S 70.° E. 127 Chs to a position XIII thence S 45.° W. 20.50 Chs to a Red Oak XIII an John Medwards line thence S 30.° E. Chs to a pine XIII J. D. Shumate, XIII thence S 9.° W 37 Chs to a Hickory XIII on the Beaverdam thence down the meanderings of sd Creek to the Junction of that and Mountain Creek thence up the sd Mountain Creek with the various meanderings thereof to an ash XIII thence N 10.° E 8.85 Chs to a pine XIII Seaborns corner on the above mentioned tract.
