 Whereas I the said *Thomas Doolin* in and by my certain note or obligation  
 bearing date the nineteenth day of February Eighteen Hundred and thirty  
 stand firmly held and bound unto *Samuel Mobley* in the sum of eight  
 hundred and fifteen dollars with interest thence due from the 20<sup>th</sup> February  
 A.D. 1830 by my note of hand as and by the said note reference being  
 thence to had, with more to be appear. Now know all men, that I  
 the said *Thomas Doolin* in consideration of the said debt and and sum  
 of money aforesaid and for better securing the payment thereof, to the  
 said *Samuel Mobley* according to the note, did also in consideration  
 of the further sum of three dollars to wit the said *Thomas Doolin* in hand  
 well and truly paid by the said *Samuel Mobley* at and before the sealing  
 and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 I the said *Thomas J. Doolin* have granted, sold and released  
 and by these presents do grant, sell and release unto the said  
*Samuel Mobley* three negroes namely *Sam* a about forty years of  
 age, *Fanny* a about thirty five years and a boy *Anthony* a son  
 of said *Fanny*. Together with all and singular the increase of the female  
 To Have and To Hold all and singular the said Slaves unto the said  
*Samuel Mobley* his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind my  
 self & my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever de  
 fend all and singular the said Slaves unto the said *Samuel*  
*Mobley* his heirs and assigns, from and against my heirs  
 Executors and administrators and assigns & every one else lawfully  
 Claiming or to Claim the same in any part thereof provided
