Greenwich District } of the district and State aforesaid in consideration of one hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by William Moore of said State and district aforesaid have bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Moore all that tract or parcel of land of one hundred acres lying in the district aforesaid on Brushy Creek waters of Enoree River Beginning on a stake S. 45 W. 27. 25 to a gum thence S. 70. E. 2. 50 to a post oak thence S. 8 W. 19 E. 18 to a stake thence S. 70 W. 15 to a red oak thence N. 20. W. 21. to the beginning Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Moore his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Moore his heirs and assigns against my self my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this the seventh day of February 1821 and in the forty fifth year of the Independence of United States of America
