nominate, constitute and appoint Enoch Hooper my true and  
lawful attorney in fact and for me and in my name as Guardian  
aforesaid to ask demand sue for receive and recover all  
sums of money that may be coming to said Jane, Harrison and Deborah  
from their father William Hoopers estate in the District aforesaid; and  
also to ask demand receive sue for and recover from any person or per-  
-sons all their distributive share of monies, effects from their father Will-  
-iam Hoopers estate aforesaid, and also to receive demand sue for and  
recover all sums of money due and owing them from their Grand Father  
Thomas Hoopers estate late of Granville District in the State of South  
Carolina aforesaid deceased; from any person or persons holding the  
same and for me as Guardian to sign receipts Bonds and papers to any  
person that may be requisite in and about the premises; and gener-  
-ally to do and perform all acts as my attorney in and about recovering  
all monies coming from said William Hoopers estate, and Thomas  
Hoopers estate from any administrator Executor court of Ordinary or any  
person or persons whatever so fully and amply as if the said Guardian  
might or could do were I personally present at the doing of the same.  
ratifying and confirming all that my said attorney may legally do  
and revoking all power or powers of Attorney by me heretofore made.
