by these Presents do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Enoch

our names to ask, demand, receive sue for and recover all sums
of money that may be due and owing to us from our Father's es-
tate. to wit the said William Hooper, being our distributive share
and portion of his estate in the hands of any person or persons in
the State of South Carolina or elsewhere; and to sign, seal and
deliver for us and in our names all proper and requisite receipts
Bonds or other instruments and vouchers for the same to any per-
son or persons, Executors, administrators, Clerk, Sheriff Court of the
