 them to be educated in such a manner as shall be suitable to their  
 interest and circumstances and that you enquire into and take  
 charge of their Estate both real and personal and all other things  
 do which by law you ought to do for your said ward a true and  
 perfect account of all which you shall render into the Court  
 of Ordinary on the first term in every year during your con-  
 tinuance in office and we do hereby constitute and appoint  
 you the said Susannah Pice Guardian of the said Orphans dur-  
 ing their minority in testimony whereof I have officially set  
 my hand and seal this sixth day of March 1826 and fiftieth
