This indenture made this 6<sup>th</sup> day of October 1818 Between Charles Gosnell of State of South Carolina and District Greenville of the one part. and Morris Gosnell of the state and aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to him in hand paid by the S. Morris Gosnell the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged hath bargained, sold and delivered and by these presents doth bargain sell and deliver unto the S. Morris Gosnell his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being on the head or near the head of South paolitt river it being a tract of land granted to the Charles Gosnell bearing date the 3<sup>d</sup> of Apriel 1794 having such shapes and marks as follows beginning on a Buihey and running N. 20. E. 15 chains to a pointed poplar thence N. 10 chains to a stake thence S. 84 W 26 to stake thence S. 20 to a stake thence E. 20 to the beginning containing 68 acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights and premises to the same belonging or in anywise appertaining to have and to hold all and singular S. premises to the proper use and behoof of him the S. Morris Gosnell his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and for ever defend from my self my heirs or assigns or any other person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this day and year first above written signed sealed and delivered in presence of
