 3x thence S. 76 1/2 E. 15-50 to a hickory 3x Bounded by Abner Nixons land
 thence S. 56 E. 41. 50. to a small hickory 3x bounding on Joseph McCalloughs
 land thence S. 47 W. 40-50 to the beginning bounded by said Thomas Lowrys land to-
 gether with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurten-
 ances thereunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. I have
 and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said George French
 his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs
 Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
 singular the said premises unto the said George French his heirs and
 assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or
 persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
