Dickie of the District and State aforesaid for the sum of forty dollars being the highest sum that was biden therefore Now know ye that I James McDaniel Sheriff of Greenville District aforesaid, by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the statute in such case and provided any for and in consideration of the said sum of forty dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Lewis H. Dickie the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Lewis H. Dickie his heirs and assigns for ever as fully and absolutely as I the said James McDaniel Sheriff aforesaid might, could, or ought to grant bargain or sell the same by virtue of the statute aforesaid and the said writ of Fieri Facias or otherwise in witness whereof I the said James McDaniel Sheriff have hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty. sealed, signed, and delivered
