The State of South Carolina.

Whereas there being a lot of land situate in the Town of Greenville in the State aforesaid on the East-side of Main Street-known in the plan of said Town as Lot No. 9. at the corner of Main and Broad Streets running on Main Street S. 16. W. 140. feet, and on Broad Street S. 74. E. 117 1/2 feet- which Lot has been usually called the Beth Lot and whereas J. Vardry McBe of Lincoln Co. only of the State of North Carolina having purchased of Col L. J. Abston all the Land and unsold Lots in or about the said town of Greenville which were not previously conveyed by the said Abston, and it appears that there is no record of any conveyance made by said Abston to the said McBe or any other person of the aforesaid Lot of Land and whereas I the said Vardry McBe have, for the reasons above stated, agreed that the said Lot of Land should be exposed at public sale provided the proceeds were appropriated for the purpose of building a market House in the said town of Greenville which sale was made on the first Monday of November A.D. 1829. and the said Lot was purchased by David Henning of the district and state first above mentioned for the sum of one hundred & seventy seven dollars. Now Know all men by these presents that in pursuance of the above mentioned agreement I do hereby relinquish unto the said David Henning his heirs and assigns, all the right title or claim of in or to the said Lot of Land which I may have by virtue of the above mentioned purchase from the said Abston, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the Lot of Land aforesaid unto the said David Henning his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs only, and against no other person or persons. Witness my hand and seal this Eight day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty, and fifty fourth year of American Independence, signed sealed and delivered in presence of B. Dunham, Joseph Powell } Vardry McBe Seal
