District aforesaid. Have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do
grant bargain sell & release unto the said Edmond Waddill all that plantation or
tract of land lying ^{or being} in the State & District aforesaid. Containing two hundred
acres (more or less) lying on the Long branch, in being one half of a tract
of land originally granted to Esther Thomas & by her sold & conveyed to Benja-
min Perry being the upper half of said tract beginning at a post oak on the
North side of the long branch running thence S 45° W 36 chs & 30 links to a post
Oak To said Tract. thence S 45° E 44 chs 29 links to a supposed corner. thence
N 45° E. 46 chs 30 links to a supposed corner. thence N 44° W. to the beginning. —
Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appur-
tenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertain-
ing (To have & to hold) all & singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said Edmond Waddill his heirs & assigns for ever. and I do her-
-ely bind myself my heirs Executors. adm^{rs} & assigns to warrant & forever
defend the said premises unto the said Edmond Waddill his heirs & assigns
against my self & my heirs & against every other person or persons whom-
-soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof —
