I know all men by these presents that I Edward Croft of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars, to me paid by Rawlin's Lander Esqr. of the same place have granted bargained, sold & released, & by these presents do grant, bargain, sell & release unto the said Rawlin's Lander a certain tract of land situated in the District of Greenville aforesaid & contains one hundred and ~~the~~ ²³¹ acre of land be the same more or less, lying and being on the waters of Richland Creek beginning at a red oak 3^t on the Spartanburgh Road, thence S. 58° E. 29.50 chs. to a pine 3^t thence S. 072° E. 24 chs. to a Stake 3^t thence N. 9° W. 17. chs. to a Hickory 3^t thence S. 85° E. 14 chs. to a chestnut 3^t thence N. 16° W. 90.40 chs. to a red Oak 3^t thence S. 074° W. 30. to a poplar 3^t thence N. 25° W. 12 chs. to a red oak 3^t thence S. 50° W. down the Spartanburgh Road 23.80 chs. to the beginning bounded by lands of Watson Cuttbert Leach, Grun & Herring the same being the said piece of Land formerly Conveyed by Nimrod Underwood to said Edward Croft together with all & singular the rights, members, Hereditaments, & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Rawlin's Lander his heirs and assigns for ever and I the said Edward Croft do hereby bind myself & my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said Rawlin's Lander his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs; and also against all & every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
