Peden of the County of Todd and State of Kentucky have and  
do by these presents make or claim constitute and appoint our brother  
John Peden of the same County and State aforesaid our true and law-  
-ful attorney in fact to make seal of our Property of a certain  
tract or parcel of land supposed to contain four hundred  
Acres more or less lying and being in the State of South Carolina  
and County of Greenville it being the same tract or parcel of land  
that descended to us James John & William Peden by our deceased  
father John Peden, our said Attorney is hereby fully authorized  
in our name to grant Bargain sell and Convey any portion  
of said tract of land which is our third each he said attorney  
being the law full owner of the other third; and our said attorney  
is hereby authorized to sell said Land for us for such price as  
he can get and to Convey all the Right title and Interest we  
have in & to said Land by General or special warranty deed  
and hereby fully authorize our said attorney to Receive the pay or  
purchase money for said Land and give Receipt for the  
Same And do each and every thing Respecting said Land that  
we could do were we present hereby ratifying And Confirming  
all of his acts Respecting said Land In testimony whereof we  
have hereunto set our hands and affixed our Seals this 17<sup>th</sup> day  
of November in the year 1830. Inte.
