sold and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver unto the
said James Bowen four Slaves namely, Eliza, Maria, Rachel and Liza to
have and to hold to him and his heirs forever with their future increase
as an indemnity against the said Bond given to the Ordinary as aforesaid and
it is a quiet between the parties to these presents that the said Slaves
shall remain in the possession of the said Vincent, to secure and enjoy
them without let or hindrance until the said James shall have sustain
