 -taining. To Have and To Hold, all and singular the premises before men-
 tioned, unto the said Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns forever
 And I do hereby bind myself heirs Executors and administrators to warrant
 and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said
 Jeremiah Cleveland his heirs and assigns, against myself, and against every
 person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part

 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one and
 in the fifty fifth year of the Independence of the United States of Amer-
