 to us paid in hand by John Clark of the aforesaid State and district
 Have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain
 sell and release unto the said John Clark all that tract or parcel
 of land containing fifty six acres more or less situate lying and being
 in the District and State aforesaid on a branch of Rudy River having
 such shape form marks and boundaries as are laid down in a plat herunto
 annexed it being part of a tract of land Originally granted to Jacob
 Smith Rhodes. Together with all the rights members Hereditaments and
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to
 Have and to Hold all and singular the bargained premises unto the said
 Clark his heirs and assigns forever And we the said John Charles and
 Barksdale D. Garrison do by these presents bind our selves our heirs and
 assigns to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said bar-
 gained premises unto the said John Clark against the claim of any person
 or persons to the bargained premises or any part thereof In witness
 whereof we the said John Charles and Barksdale D. Garrison do here-
 unto set our hands and affixed our seals this Eighth day of January
 in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty one
 and in the fifty fifth Year of the Independence of the United States
