

Greenville Dist: Know all men by these presents that I, Thom-  
 South Carolina - as B. Williams of the district and State aforesaid  
 in consideration of Eight hundred dollar to me paid in hand by James  
 W. Thompson the acct. of which is hereby acknowledged have bargained,  
 sold, and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver unto  
 said Thompson that parcel or tract of land lying on Saluda River  
 known by the name of Mrs. Harriess tract containing three hundred  
 and thirty nine acres more or less, being a part of a tract of land  
 granted to William Young the fifth day of June 1786 conveyed by W<sup>m</sup>  
 Young to W<sup>m</sup> Matthews Sr. and from part of said land conveyed to W<sup>m</sup>  
 Matthews Jr. and conveyed by W<sup>m</sup> Matthews Jr. to Mrs. Blankinship and  
 conveyed from Mrs. Blankinship to Mrs. Harriess the balance of said land  
 conveyed by Gen: Mrs. Blankinship and Samuel Townes to Mrs. Harriess and  
 together with all and singular the rights, hereditaments & appertenan-  
 ces to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertain-  
 ing: - To have and to hold all and singular the premises before men-  
 tioned unto the said Jas. W. Thompson his heirs & assigns forever and  
 do hereby warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises  
 unto the said J. W. Thompson his heirs and assigns against all claim  
 whatsoever witness my hand and seal this twenty fifth day of  
 October in the year of our Lord 1831. - signed, sealed in the  
 presence of Richard J. Mays - Eliza A. Mays - Tho<sup>s</sup>. B. Williams (seal)

 Greenville District - Rich<sup>d</sup>. J. Mays and made oath that he saw Tho<sup>s</sup>.  
 B. Williams sign seal and acknowledge the within deed of conveyance  
 for the uses and purposes within mentioned and that Eliza A. Mays  
 was with himself a subscribing witness to the same sworn to and subscri-  
 bed this 10<sup>th</sup> November 1831. before

 hereby acknowledged, have given, granted, bargained, sold, released and  
 conveyed, and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, sell, release and  
 convey unto Baylis J. Cole, Jeremiah Cleaveland Senr. Richard Houston  
 Richard Harrison and George Fleming Esquires, Trustees of the Baptist  
 Church to be erected near the village of Greenville and their  
 successors in office all that lot, piece or parcel of land situated  
 lying and being in the district of Greenville in the state of South  
 Carolina on the Eastern boundary of said Village: Beginning at  
 a stake at the East end of Avenue Street, thirty three feet from the  
 East corner of Mr. Crawford's Lot on a direct line with said in  
 running thence N. 16 E. sixty feet to a stake thence S. 74 E. one hundred
