 Thomas Goldsmith all that tract or parcel of land, containing
 two hundred acres be the same more or less, part of which being part of a
 tract originally granted to Nathaniel Reed containing 353 acres - the 5th day
 of June 1786 & Recorded in grant Book M. M. M. M. Page - the balance
 being a part of a tract of 463 Acres originally granted to James Harrison
