 bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant
 and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto
 the said Elijah Smith his heirs & assigns against myself & my
 heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
 the same or any part thereof. witness my hand and seal this the
 24 of September one thousand Eight hundred & thirty in the
 year of our Lord and in 56th year of the independance of
 the U.S. States of America.

 in hand paid by William Jacobs of the same place have granted
 bargained, sold and released and do by these presents, grant, bargain sell
 and release unto the said William Jacobs a certain piece parcel or
 tract of land situate in the District and State aforesaid on the Ac-
 -qustia Road two miles and a half below Greenville Court House and
 branches of Brushy Creeks waters of Pine. Bounded on the N. by bar-
 -dry M. Bees land on the S. W. Jacobs land and on the W. by J. Gor-
 -dons land and having such form and marks as a plat annexed
 to a grant made to James Bennie bearing date the 2nd February A.D. 1829
 a reference thereto will more fully shew. containing one hundred
 acres. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments
 and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
 or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises
 unto the said William Jacobs his heirs and assigns from me and
 my heirs and no further. In witness whereof I have herewith
