 rie of the City of Charleston in the said State, Trustee of James Gregorie and Ann Gibbs
 Ladsen Gregorie his wife. Have granted, Bargained, sold, released, conveyed and confirmed and
 by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release, convey and confirm unto the said J. Ladsen Gregorie
 Trustee as aforesaid all that plantation piece or tract of land situate, lying and being in the said
 of Greenville on Golden Grove Creek waters of Saluda River containing three hundred and ninety
 seven and five tenths acres more or less: Beginning on the said creek at the mouth of a branch
 and running up said Branch to a white oak thence S. 75. W. 25 to a stake thence N. 40 E. 35 a-
 cross the Road to a stake thence N. 10 1/2 E. 57 to a poplar on a branch thence down the
 last mentioned Branch to a maple at the mouth of another Branch thence N. 84 W. 10. 50
 across said Branch to white oak thence S. 85 W. 37. 50 to poplar on the said Golden Grove creek
 and thence down the meanders of the said creek to a gum at the Beginning corner in-
