 Release unto the Said William Wheeler Senr all that parcel or tract
 of Land lying on the West Side of Eedy River supposed to be by Compu-
 tation thirty five acres be the same more or less Beginning on a branch
 below the School House Spring where Reubin Martins line crosses thence
 down said Branch to the lower corner of an old field to a conditional
 Maple Corner maid between said Gibson and William Thruston thence
 a north wardedly direction a conditional line to a post oak corner above
 the old Field near the top of the Ridge thence West of north on open line
 to a maple on John W Daniels line thence with said Daniels line to Reubin
 Martins line thence with said Martins line to the Beginning Together with
 all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments and appertainances
 thereunto belonging in any wise appertaining to have and to hold all
 and singular the said premises unto the said William Wheeler Senr
 his heirs or assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
 Executors or administrators to warrant and forever defend all and
 singular the aforesaid premises unto the said William Wheeler Senr
 his heirs against myself my heirs Executors administrators and assigns
 forever in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 24th day
 of June one thousand Eight hundred and thirty one

23 This Indenture made this the Twenty first day of January 1832
 Between William Russel of the State of Seneca and County of Cook of
 the first part and Daniel Pace of the State of South Carolina and district
 of Greenville of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration
 of Twenty five dollars in hand paid to the said William Russel the Rec-
 eipt and payment of which is hereby acknowledged hath granted
 and Bargained Sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents
 doth Give Grant Bargain and Sell convey and confirm unto the said
 Daniel Pace a certain tract or Parcel of Land lying and being in
 the State South Carolina and District of Greenville on the Waters of
 Fall Creek joining land belonging to Elexsander McKenny on the
 South Side and Thomas Morgain and Squire Morgain on the north side
 containing Two hundred acres be the same more or less which Land was
 granted to William Russel in 1814 beginning at a poplar thence south
